



**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ACQUIRE  
DERELICT SITES COMPULSORILY, UNDER THE  
DERELICT SITES ACT, 1990, (AS AMENDED BY  
THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000).**

Notice is hereby given that Dublin City Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by s. 14 of the *Derelict Sites Act 1990 (as amended by the Planning and Development Act 2000)*, intends to acquire compulsorily, under the said Act, the derelict sites described hereunder.

Maps of the said derelict sites may now be inspected in the **Derelict Sites Section, Block 4, Floor 2, Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8** during office hours. Copies of the maps may also be viewed online at <http://bit.ly/DerelictSites>

Any owner, lessee or occupier (except a tenant for a month or a period less than a month) may on or before **Tuesday 12th June, 2018** submit to the Council an objection to the proposed compulsory acquisition of any of these derelict sites. Any such objection must be in writing, stating the grounds of the objection and addressed to:

*The Derelict Sites Act 1990 (as amended by the Planning and Development Act 2000) provides that if an objection is made to the proposed compulsory acquisition of a derelict site and the objection is not withdrawn, the derelict site shall not be acquired compulsorily by the Council without the consent of An Bord Pleanála.*
